May 25 - Deadline for enrollment

May 25th & 26th Auditions: will take place. **You must be enrolled to participate in the auditions!**
Missed rehearsals and/or family vacations during camp may have an impact on casting choices.

May 25th Audition by appointment: 10AM – 2PM Individual singing and monologue audition, by appointment! We will schedule these audition slots once you have enrolled.

May 26th Callbacks: ALL CALLED! 1 – 5PM for dance and reading of scenes
Place: Rehearsal Hall at 6th Street Playhouse

Audition Form: Please fill out the audition form and bring with you for the audition along with a current picture or 'head shot'.

April 15th Audition Materials: Songs selection, video for dance preparation and scene 'sides' will be posted on this site and also will be sent by email to all enrollees.

Note: All participants paying tuition will have the opportunity to perform in this production. Roles may be double cast. All participants will be issued a script and music on May 25th before you leave the audition. West Side Story is filled with a host of parts for a diverse wide cross-section of students and an abundance of energetic production numbers.

May 27th Casting: will be emailed to you. Once you have been cast, please begin your 'work' on the show. Read the script, learn lines, and familiarize yourself with all songs in which you will participate.

May 29th Documentation: You will receive a packet of documents by email you need to complete and return by: **June 5th Deadline to return documentation**
