Interested in organizing a corporate event, tour activity, fundraiser, or social occasion with friends and family?

Purchase 20 or more tickets to a 6th Street Playhouse performance to qualify for a group sale! To book your group, contact the Box Office, (707) 523-4185 ext.1 or boxoffice@6thstreetplayhouse.com. You may also visit in person at 52 W 6th Street in Santa Rosa (open M-F 1-4 pm, Sat 11-2 pm). Group sales discounts are not available online.

- ❖ Fill out the group sales form and contact us once you have the required information.

- ❖ At that that time you can pay the amount in full, or a 50% non-refundable deposit. (Full payment due 30 days prior to performance)

- ❖ Once your order is completed, we will send you a confirmation, your tickets, and a seat map showing where your tickets are located!

Note: Please let us know at the time of booking whether handicapped accessible seating is needed.

GROUP SALES FAQ

How many tickets am I required to purchase to qualify for a group discount?

During our scheduled season, you need to purchase a minimum of 20 tickets to qualify for a group sale. If you don't have the minimum, you can still purchase group tickets, but they will be full-priced.

What is the ticket price per person?

The price per ticket will be calculated using the highest ticket price available for the performance you choose. For Musicals, we offer 20% off, and for Plays 15%. We also have options for "Buying Out the House", where your group would have the theatre to yourselves! Contact us for more details.

Is there a group discount for all performances?

Most performances offer group pricing and all reservations are made on a space-available basis. The earlier you reserve, the more likely you will get the performance date and time you desire. We do not offer group discounts on any School of Drama or improv comedy productions.

Can we book a reception or plan an event on our performance date?

There may be opportunities to book a private reception, please contact to see what dates may be available. We also book Preview Partners for private preview performances of each season show, this can be arranged through our Preview Partner Coordinator, Sue Byrne, who can be reached at previews@6thstreetplayhouse.com

How do I get my tickets? Can I pick them up in will-call?

Tickets are available for pick-up from the Box Office any time after the final payment is made, we can also send tickets in the mail via the USPS. We dissuade groups from picking up their tickets at will-call on the day of the performance, however, we understand if this your only option. The group leader will need to make arrangements to pick up tickets at will-call, as tickets can not be left in will-call for group members to pick up individually. .

Can I bring a group of children to a performance?

Our scheduled season shows are best suited for those ages 5 and up. Any age restrictions or recommendations will be listed on the show page. Children must occupy their own seat, no lap sitting or babes in arms, and all persons entering the theatre, regardless of age, must have their own ticket. Performances are often more than two hours long and not always suitable for younger children.
